

The Nyack Library Rules of Conduct

The Nyack Library Board of Trustees invites the public to enjoy the library, its materials, its special services and its programs.

PLEASE

- Do relax comfortably in the library with a good book, interesting magazine or newspaper.
- Do use the library for pleasure reading, homework assignments and research.
- Do come to the library for the quiet use of its varied collections and electronic resources to participate in one of its many programs or services or to check out materials.
- Do take advantage of the expertise of the library staff to answer questions and give assistance.
- Do bring your children to use the Children's Room and the child-friendly facilities as well as take part in its programs.

*Users of the library must respect the rights and privileges of all users.
Any behavior which interferes with the use of the library by others is prohibited.*

For the comfort and safety of everyone, we ask your cooperation:

- Do not misuse or move library equipment or furniture.
- Do not leave children under 8 years old unattended or in the responsibility of someone under 14 years old.
- Do not loiter (i.e.: sit or stand idly about), sleep, hang out, linger aimlessly, or move around to engage in conversation, etc.
- Do not talk or laugh in a loud voice.
- Do not use obscene and/or abusive language.
- Do not place feet on tables or chairs.
- Do not run, jump, or engage in horsing around.
- Do not eat food or drink beverages in the library.
- Do not bring animals into the library or tie them in front of the library entrances; Seeing Eye dogs are permitted.
- Do not ride skateboards or in-line skates inside the library.
- Do not block the steps, doorways or walkways with bicycles, strollers or persons.
- Do not use cellular telephones inside the library.
- Do not engage in behavior which is inappropriate or disruptive to other users, or which threatens the safety, security or privacy of another individual.
- No gambling or card playing.
- No smoking.
- No soliciting, selling, petition signing, etc.
- Shoes and shirts are required at all times in the library.

The violation of any rule or otherwise inappropriate behavior may lead to suspensions of library privileges or exclusion from the library premises. Library staff may request users to show their library cards or other appropriate identification.
